DATES: SATURDAY, MAY 1, 2010
SUNDAY, JULY 11, 2010
SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2010

RULES: NRA and CMP rules will apply.
TARGET: NRA SR-1 (200 Yard target reduced to 100 yards).

CLASSIFICATION: For the Garand Match, all competitors will be shooting in a single class.

ENTRY FEES: \$10.00 per competitor.

POST ENTRIES: Post entries will be accepted up to the range limits, provided that they do not delay the match or require extra relays or targets. Setup and registration starts at 0800 and ends at 0850 on match day. Firing begins at 0900.

SCORING: Competitors will be required to score each others targets. CMP official score cards will be sent to the CMP for posting on their web site.

CONDITIONS GOVERNING THE MATCH:

- A. **RULES:** This match is governed by the rules prescribed by the Civilian Marksmanship Program.
- B. **OPEN TO:** Any citizen of the United States, 16 years of age or older.
- C. **COURSE OF FIRE:** John C. Garand Match, Course B, 50 Shots at 100 Yards.
 - 1st Stage - Slow Fire, Prone, 5 sighting shots (5 minutes) and 20 record shots (20 minutes).
 - 2nd Stage - Rapid Fire, Prone from standing, 10 shots in 70 seconds.
 - 3rd Stage - Rapid Fire, Sitting from standing, 10 shots in 60 seconds.
 - 4th Stage - Slow Fire, Standing, 10 shots in 10 minutes.

Shooters may elect to shoot less than 5 sighting shots. Sighting shots will be marked at the targets before the beginning of shots for record.

- D. **ARMS:** As-issued U.S. rifle, caliber .30 M1903 Springfield; caliber .30 M1917 Enfield; caliber .30 M1 Garand; caliber .30 M1941 Johnson; and U.S. carbine caliber .30 M1.

- E. **AMMUNITION:** Any safe ammunition. M2 ball surplus ammunition MAY be available for purchase at CMP prices in an amount sufficient to complete the match.

COMPETITORS SHOULD BRING SUFFICIENT AMMO OF THEIR OWN IN THE EVENT CMP AMMO IS NOT AVAILABLE.

SQUADDING: Squadding will be accomplished at the time of entry for the match. An Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement must be on file for all competitors prior to participation in this match.

CERTIFICATES OF COMPETITION: CMP Certificates of Competition will be distributed to competitors for completion of the match.

Note: Participation in this match will entitle the competitor to purchase an M1 Garand from the CMP. Participation also satisfies the CMP requirement to fire 50 shots in an NRA, CMP or USA Shooting sanctioned rifle competition.
